

Privacy Policy

LAST UPDATED: August 30, 2021

This Privacy Policy (the "Privacy Policy" or "Policy") describes and regulates all services on the Website, processing and use of your personal data on the Website.

By accessing or using the Website means that you have read, agree and consent to the data collection and use practices described in this Privacy Policy.

Information We May Collect

The information we may store only what is required and absolutely necessary for us to provide the Website and support to users of the Website, whether the information you gave to or the one we collect.

Personal Data

Personal data or personal information is all the information that identifiable an individual but not including data where the identity has been removed (anonymous data).

Anonymous Data

We may share and disclose your anonymous data with service providers or with others we conduct business with. In addition, we may further integrate your anonymous information with data from other visitors in order to develop our Website.

To understand how the Website is used, we may use statistical data or demographics for our understanding of the user's view to improve the Website and to analyse usage patterns.



Usage Data

Usage data will automatically be collected whenever you visit the Website. This information may be collected either by us or the third-parties, including but not limited to, your IP address, browser type and version, the pages of the Website that you visit, time zone setting, country, the time spent on those pages, operating system, unique device identifiers, and other non-personal identifiable data.

Purpose for Collecting Your Personal Data

- Detect, prevent and spot technical issues;
- Surveys and get feedback;

- Prepare any legal and regulatory requirements when required.

Consent

Consent is required for the collection of personal data and the subsequent use or disclosure of personal data. By accessing or using the Website, you signify your agreement to our Terms of Use and Privacy Policy constituting your consent to the collection and use of personal data as described in this Privacy Policy. We are rightfully to use and disclose personal data without noticing you or consent as permitted by applicable law.

Disclosure of Personal Data

We have all the right to disclose personal data when we found that it is proper or needed to enforce our Terms of Use, take precautions against liability or harm, to investigate and respond to third-party claims or allegations, to respond to a court order, law enforcement or other government official requests, for security or integrity of the Website and to protect the rights, property or to secure the Website, our usage or whatsoever.



We may share or disclose aggregated or anonymised data with service providers or with others for their own uses, including but not limited to, potential third-parties.

The personal data that you gave to us might be delivered to our service providers, contractors and anyone else who makes improvements to our services for any of these purposes. We use personal data for indicating the time you have us such data, and/or otherwise for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy and/or as otherwise permitted by law. We may make available the personal data that you provide to us to our service providers, contractors and anyone else to enable them to perform certain services or tasks for us for these purposes.

Third-Party Service Providers

All third-party services are regulated by their own terms of service and privacy policies. We have no control and will not take any responsibility for the content, policies, services or practices of any third-parties.

We may use the third-party services to facilitate services, provide services on our behalf, perform service-related services or help us understand how the Website is used.

We may also use third-party service providers to monitor and analyse the use of the Website.

Access and Change to Personal Data

Data Security
